

Competition Rules

- 1. The layout's length and width must be in the ratio 40:25, with a maximum length of 80 cm and width of 50 cm. If a fiddle yard is used it must be wholly contained within the 40:25 area. The height is unlimited, within reason.
- 2. The power supply, lighting and control panel can extend outside the maximum size.
- 3. The model may be of any scale or gauge, but must depict a narrow gauge line.
- 4. Particular credit will be given for the ingenuity and originality of the design, as well as the quality of the modelling.
- 5. The layout must operate and trains be seen to move.
- 6. Only one layout may be submitted per entrant.
- 7. Layouts entered for this competition must not have been submitted in previous years.
- 8. Entries will be judged at Expo Narrow Gauge 2008.
- 9. Intending competitors are invited to request an entry form and must return the completed form by 31 July 2008, so that sufficient space can be allocated.
- 10. The judges' decision is final.
