

## The Dave Brewer Memorial Challenge

Expo Narrow Gauge – 28th October 2017

For the 2017 Challenge the theme is 'The Halt', a small, wayside stop alongside a single, narrow gauge track. No loop, no sidings, just a single line of rails. The model is to be a diorama and is not required to operate.

- 1. The model may use any scale and gauge combination, as long as it represents a narrow (ie less than 4 ft 8.5 ins) gauge, with a maximum gauge of 45 mm.
- 2. Any structures may be wholly scratch-built, or use parts from kits or commercial models, but no unaltered kits or commercial models can be used.
- 3. A train or rolling stock may be placed on the track, if desired.
- 4. To ensure we can fit entries into the available space please use these maximum sizes:
  - a. 80 cm by 30 cm by 40 cm high for gauges 32 mm and above, to a maximum of 45 mm.
  - b. 60 cm by 25 cm by 30 cm high for gauges 14 mm and above, but less than 32 mm.
  - c. 50 cm by 20 cm by 25 cm high for gauges 9 mm and above, but less than 14 mm.
  - d. 40 cm by 15 cm by 20 cm high for all gauges below 9 mm.
- 5. Any lighting can be above the height limit.
- 6. The model should not have been entered in any previous competition.
- 7. To be eligible, completed entry forms must be received by 31st August 2017.
- 8. To be eligible, models must be presented for judging at Expo Narrow Gauge 2017
- 9. A prize, including one year's subscription to Narrow Gauge World, will be awarded to the winner.
- 10. The judges' decision is final.
